

# \* INSTRUCTIONS \*


Use a coffee filter and the paper templates on the next pages to make a simple frog craft!


Begin by coloring the frog body template pieces. Then cut them out as separate parts. Color a white basketstyle coffee filter green.


Lay the colored coffee filter onto the center of a piece of construction paper. Don't glue it in place yet. Have students place the feet underneath the lower edge of the coffee filter and glue them down.


Then they can add the legs on either side underneath the filter. Glue them in place. Finally glue the coffee filter on top and glue the eyes onto the top of the head. A color version is also included.
